



# Empowering Learning at Goring C. of E. Primary

Goring C. of E. Primary nestles in the Goring Gap, upon the River Thames in South Oxfordshire. The school was founded in 1855 and provides education to the local community.

## Project Objective

Enhancing education through the setup of a computer area for teaching computer skills and supplementing traditional learning methods.

## Background

Goring C. of E. Primary, wanted to supplement its teaching methods by providing a dedicated computer area to provide instant access to technology. Recognising the need for a computer area, the school collaborated with claireLOGIC, an Abingdon based IT company, who were more than keen to support local community initiatives.

## Solution

claireLOGIC worked closely with Goring C. of E. Primary to set up a dedicated computer area equipped with a number of PCs. The project aimed to facilitate teaching of basic computer skills and promote an interactive and engaging learning environment for the students.
